AFFIRMATIVE INSTRUMENTS

[Animal By-Products and Animal Health \(Miscellaneous Fees\) \(Scotland\) Regulations 2023 \(SSI 2023/Draft\)](#)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

George Adam on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau: That the Parliament agrees that the Animal By-Products and Animal Health (Miscellaneous Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2023 (SSI 2023/Draft) be approved.

Purpose

2. To introduce changes to the Animal and Plant Health Agency fees structure to modify the statutory fees to achieve full cost recovery for delivery of statutory services provided for Animal By-Products, Salmonella Control Programmes, Artificial Breeding Controls, checks on live animals at Border Control Posts and the Poultry Health Scheme for work carried out to allow operators to trade domestically and/or internationally.

Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 31 May 2023 the Rural Affairs and Islands Committee agreed to recommend that the regulations be approved. The Committee report was published on 13 June 2023.
